The purpose of ministry is to empower individuals because God's works of service is to be done by individuals not ministers alone. Individuals are expected to be faithful witnesses of God in and out of faith centers. The workplace is a very fruitful place for ministry by individuals "preach" each day through the conduct of their lives. When the behavior of people of faith start to reflect their teachings, people around them are more likely to come to God.

Surefooting encourages individuals to live out their faith in the workplace in a respectful way, knowing that work is an attribute of God's creation. We wish to clearly communicate God's purpose for work; to present work (paid or unpaid), career or business, as a calling and opportunity for ministry. We also wish to teach principles for living out faith in workplace setting by presenting faith-based leadership and management principles, and the need for corporate prayer in the workplace.

Surefooting coaches individuals seeking career direction or change, and those looking for meaningful jobs. We also work with entrepreneurs to build businesses or to recover from business decline and failure.

Surefooting does not push for an overt conversion of others in the workplace to a particular faith—although it is a desirable outcome—the main goal is to work with individuals as they strive to become one with God; learn to commit every detail of their daily activities or projects into God's hands; seek to become a better employee, manager, leader or employer; and seek to make a positive impact in the workplace. We work with individuals to re-shape or change their thought patterns, habits, attitudes and observable behaviours.
