**Spirituality in the Office (SITO)** is set up to encourage and facilitate the living out of faith by believers in an office or workplace setting. It provides coaching for change and challenges.

The Bible states in Ephesians 6:11-12 that "It was he who gave some to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be evangelists, and some to be pastors and teachers, to prepare God's people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up." (NIV) The purpose of ministry is to build up the Church but the work of the ministry is to be done by committed believers not just the ministers. The works of service by committed believers include bringing others to the knowledge of Jesus Christ by the way they live out their faith and engaging in activities that benefit others and society at large.
