Surefooting Coaching + Workplace Ministry is set up to encourage and facilitate the living out of faith by individuals in a workplace setting. It provides coaching for change and challenges. We believe that God is our strength! God makes us as surefooted as a deer, able to walk on the steep mountains.

The purpose of ministry is to empower individuals as God's works of service is to be done by individuals not ministers alone. The work of ministers is that of preparing individuals for God's works of service that include bringing others to the knowledge of God. The works of service are done by individuals as they live out their faith and engage in activities that benefit others and society at large. Individuals are expected to be faithful witnesses of God in all that they are involved in including their paid work. The workplace is a very fruitful place for ministry. All individuals preach everyday and everywhere by their lives. People will come to God when they observe a high degree of similarity between lives individuals live and their faith teachings.

We seek to encourage individuals to live out their faith in a workplace setting in a respectful way with an understanding of work as an extension of God's creation work. We seek to bring out clearly God's purpose for work; to present work (paid or unpaid), career or business as a ministry calling; and to teach principles for living out faith in workplace setting. We will present faith-based leadership and management principles and teach the need for spiritual warfare in the workplace. We seek to coach individuals, who have lost their jobs, need to change careers or suffered business decline and failure to stand up again and rediscover God's eternal purpose for their lives. Our activities include organization of seminars, workshops, business networks, publishing and intercessory activities.

Surefooting does not push for an overt conversion of others in workplaces to a particular faith although it may be a by-product. The main goal is to work with individuals as they strive to become one with God; learn to commit even the minute details of their daily activities or projects into God's hands; seek to become a better employee, manager, leader or employer; and seek to make a difference/ an impact in the workplace. We will work with individuals as they seek to shape or change their thoughts, thinking patterns, attitudes and observable behaviours. A desire for a change is important as living out of faith requires a heart or mind is strongly conditioned or disposed to faith.
